

At Private Spring Water, we make every effort to ensure that our products have the lowest possible environmental impact. From our production process and delivery methods to the bottles themselves, there is no aspect of our business that has not been created without giving thought to the world around us.



Our Bottles

All of our bottles are made from rPET, the most environmentally friendly form of plastic. Plastic has the lowest carbon footprint of any water packaging method including glass and boxed water. In fact, bottled water has a smaller footprint than any other beverage category. We have implemented a stringent recycling plan, which is especially impactful because recycled plastic uses 25% less energy than virgin plastic.

Every Private Spring Water bottle is designed so that it can be recycled or easily refilled for reuse. We encourage all of our customers to make refill stations and recycling bins available at their events so that these features are even easier to take advantage of. The key to positive impact is to make sure the bottles get to the recycling plant, thereby completing the cycle so they can be made into other bottles.

Our Process

Our entire operation is 65% solar sufficient and we buy additional energy credits to achieve 100% solar sufficiency. We also try to source as many products as possible within a 100-mile radius of our plants to reduce our carbon footprint even further.

As a result of our efforts to reduce environmental impact in every aspect of our business, we like to think of our carbon footprint as more of a carbon “toe-print.” At the same time, we believe it is always important to remember that the responsibility for this impact lies with all of us and depends upon our willingness to work together to refill, reuse, and recycle.

Our Natural Spring Water

Our plant in Pennsylvania has bottled water at the source since 1927. This water source flows from the Penobscot Ridge Mountains in the Lackawanna State Forest of Pennsylvania, a majestic area with exceptional water quality and refreshing, smooth taste.

Our California plant sources from the ancient springs of the great Palomar Mountain in San Diego County, California. This rich natural spring produces thousands of gallons of water daily with consistently outstanding clarity and quality.
